The Annual Sabbaths are Sabbaths in the Feasts of the Lord to be kept like the weekly Sabbath. (No servile work and a holy convocation – a holy gathering for bible study before the Lord).

THE THIRD MONTH OF THE BIBLICAL CALENDAR: SIVAN

(The Feast of the Day of Pentecost is celebrated in the third month)

3. Day of Pentecost

(The fulfilment of first outpouring on the Jews first and then the availability of the Holy Spirit – the Comforter - to dwell in **All** believers who are obedient to the ten commandments including the seventh day Sabbath and have the faith of Jesus Christ. John 14:16-17; John 16:13-15. Acts 5:32, Rev 14:12. (The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of God and the Finger of God who writes the Law of God - the ten commandments into the hearts and minds of the true disciples of Jesus Christ. Matt 12:28; Luke 11:20. 2 Cor 3:3-6.

<p>4. Feast of Trumpets (The yet future fulfillment of the return of Jesus Christ in the air for the firstfruits of God in the first resurrection of the dead. The eternal judgement of the dead before the marriage supper of the Lamb in heaven).</p> <p>I. Those judged eternally worthy will be in the marriage supper of the Lamb</p> <p>II. The Feast of Tabernacles (7 days) Under the New Covenant the Feast of Tabernacles is no longer required to be kept by the Church of God by going to a place where God has placed his name as was the case under the Old Covenant Law of Moses for Israel in the land of Canaan. Deut 16:16 (The yet future fulfillment of the Feast of Tabernacles is the 1000 years' reign of Jesus Christ and the saints on the earth from Jerusalem to bring salvation to the world.
